Examination Rules and Regulations

Reporting time

- Please assemble at the respective exam venues at least 15 minutes before the start of the paper.

Writing Instruments

- You must bring your own stationery and any other required items (e.g. calculator) for each paper. Borrowing from other candidates is NOT allowed under any circumstances.
- Your stationery should be kept in a **transparent pencil case/ziploc bag**, and be placed on the table at all times. This is to prevent any incidents of notes being unintentionally brought into the examination venue.

Prohibited Items

- Students are not permitted to have in their possession any unauthorized materials, electronic or communication devices when in the examination venue.

Absence from School

- Students who are absent for a paper must produce a medical certificate to cover his/her absence. Medical Certificates issued by sinsehs or doctors of Traditional Chinese Medicine and letters from parents are not accepted.
- Students who are absent for a paper without a medical certificate will be given AB ('0' marks) for the paper that they missed.
